- Demonstrate financial need
- Must document active participation in community service
- Essay
- Transcript & ACT/SAT scores
- Letters of recommendation
- Deadline: 3/1/09

31. Savage Elementary PTO Scholarship

- Application
- 2.5 GPA minimum
- Must have attended Savage Elementary for minimum of 3 years
- Must have been accepted to college or trade school
- Deadline: 3/27/09

32. Wayne County Vision Fund Scholarship

- 3.0 GPA minimum
- Must have been accepted to a 2 or 4 year college, university, or trade school
- Merit based; leadership, extra-curricular involvement, community service, school or faith based involvement are considerations
- 200 word statement
- Page 1 of U.S. Individual Tax Return (Form 1040)
- Two letters of recommendation
- Deadline: 3/13/09
