- Must demonstrate financial need
- Must plan to enroll in an accredited two or four-year college, university, or vocational-technical school Fall 2009
- See Ms. Buhro in the Counseling Office by March 19th to apply

Canton Lions Club Scholarship

- \$500 scholarship for a student who is visually or auditorially impaired, or a student who will enter a program in the fall that will lead to a degree which will help serve sight or hearing impaired individuals

 - Must be a member of National Honor Society
 - Involvement in extra-curricular activities, or school or community service

- Resume
- Must be the descendent of a United States Military Veteran
- 2.0 GPA minimum; 3.0 GPA maximum
- Involvement in extra-curricular activities, or school or community service
- Three letters of recommendation

- Application
- Must be accepted to an accredited college & be committed to a degree program
